

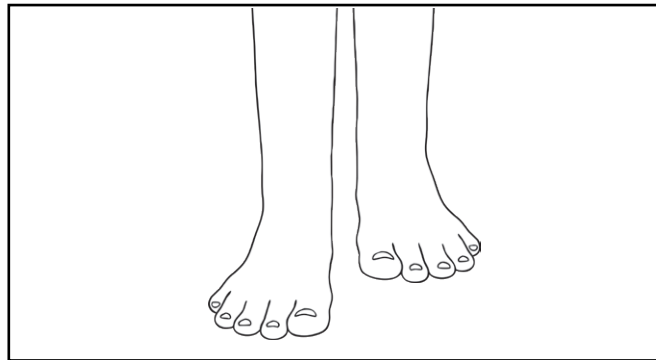
Disclaimer

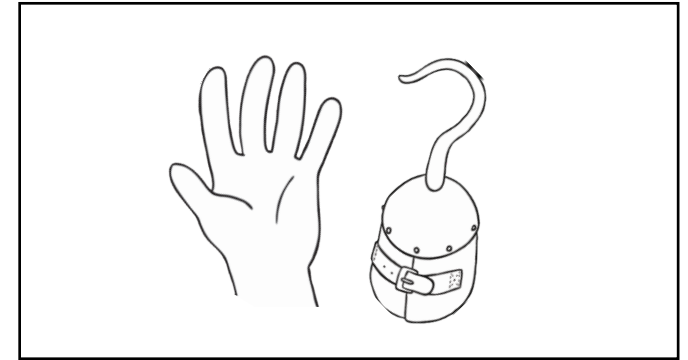
The Cook in the Wood



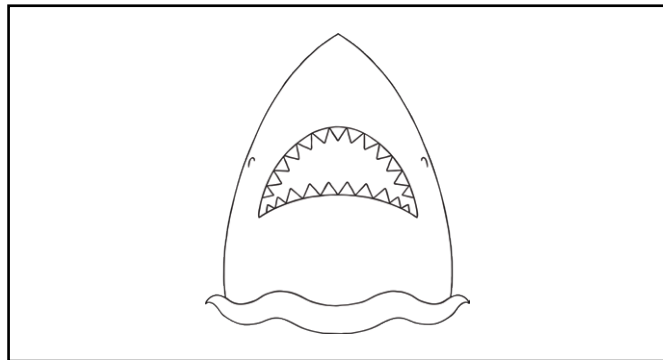
Deep in the dark woods was a cook. This cook had not been seen for years.



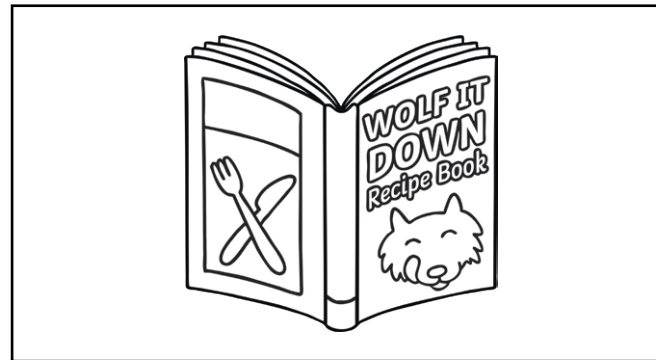
She had a good foot and a bad foot so she had to hop.



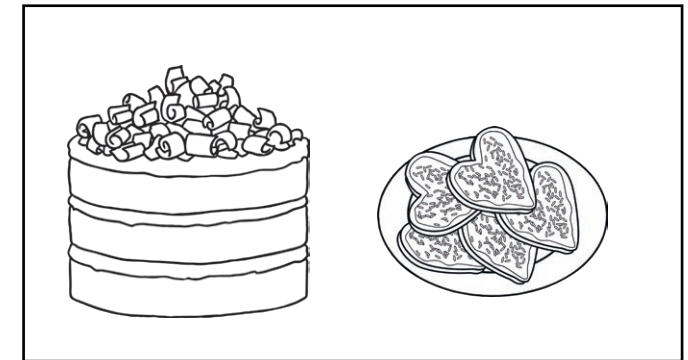
She had a good hand and a bad hand. Her left hand was a hook. This hook had been on her arm for fifteen years.
