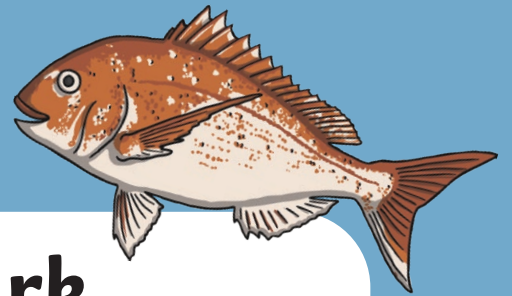


Disclaimer
