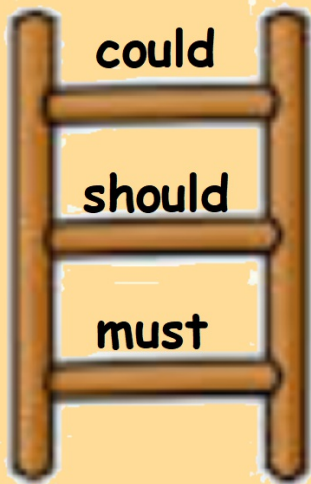




To add the suffix 'ing' to a word ending in y, which has a consonant before it.



I **could** use the spelling rule for adding ing in my independent sentences.

I **should** apply the spelling rule when adding ing to a word ending in y with a consonant before it.

I **must** identify what happens when adding ing to a word ending in y with a consonant before it.

Quick warm up

We have already looked at the rule for adding -ed -er - est to words ending in y (with a consonant before).

Can you have a go at adding -ed - est or - er to these words as a warm up ?



Change the y
into i and add
your suffix !

Do you remember
the rule ?



add - ed

cry

dry

copy

add - er
- est

happy

funny

This week we are going to learn how to add the suffix 'ing' to words ending in y, which all have a consonant before the y.

Can you see how
the spelling changes
when I add the suffix
ing?



copy	→	copying
marry	→	marrying
fly	→	flying

Did you notice that this time we don't change the y ? In fact we just add ing.



I must remember
not to change the y
this time !

carry →

Have a check !

reply	→	replying
carry	→	carrying
try	→	trying

Watch out for any words ending in a letter 'i' they also need 'ing' adding on!



WATCH OUT!

Words that end in an 'i' with a consonant before it, do not follow this pattern. Instead, leave the 'i' and add '-ing'.



I like to ski.

You are really good at skiing.



An aeroplane must taxi along the runway to get into the right place before take-off.

The little boy sucked his lollipop as the aeroplane was taxiing along the runway.



Roll a dice and add ing to the words which match the number you roll.

1. marry	2. carry	3. reply
4. copy	5. ski	6. fly

Writing - Roll the dice to select a word , add 'ing' and write the word into a sentence. Keep rolling until you have used each word.
