In Phonics, we are learning the next sounds in Level 3.

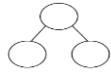
We will be reading Farmyard Hullabullo, Farmer Duck, Rosie's Walk and many non-fiction books about how a farm works.

During lessons, we will be writing more sentences independently and thinking about the sentence before we write anything.

The children will be doing more group work with different children to get used to working with different people in the class.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be looking at numbers to 10, which we need to know how to make using a 10 frame and learning how to make sums using a special grid called whole/part modelling.



We will also be looking at 3D shapes and how we use them in the classroom, height and looking at how to tell the time.

Understanding the World

We will learn about how a farm works and the jobs that a farmer has to do.

We will be having eggs in the classroom to see how they change over time. Looking at life cycles will be a key part of the lessons.
