

## English

In Phonics, we are starting to put letters together to make simple words. We are writing for different purposes throughout the day. We are recapping Level 2 sounds, which is most of the letters of the alphabet and starting level 3.

We will be reading *A Journey Through the Weather*, *The Boy and the Rainbow* and discussing about weather and patterns that we see around us.

In class, we will be communicating all together, in groups and individually in every lesson taught.

## Mathematics

In Maths we will be comparing amounts of different objects and counting them. We will be matching and sorting objects and looking at comparing size, mass and capacity.

We will make simple patterns in different ways and we will start to Dig Deeper to read round some problems.

## Understanding the World

We will be learning about the weather and how it changes throughout the year, whilst looking at the different seasons. As a class, we will look at Bonfire Night and different celebrations that lead up to Christmas.

We hope that your children are enjoying coming to school.
